Given below are the activities for the Month of July 2023:

1.Social Emotional Ethical learning

Topic: Interpersonal Skills

Classes: Pre- Nursery – Grade 2

Description: Interpersonal skills are people skills, social skills or social intelligence. Children will be involved in different interactive activities.

Day & Date: Every Monday 1st Period

Description: Through this activity:

- Children will learn to maintain eye contact with their peers.
- Paraphrasing of what peer says.
- Attention to be given to the speaker

Facilitator to talk about the importance of mutual respect while having a conversation.

1. Van Mahotsav

Description: Trees and forests play a very crucial role in maintaining an ecological balance and providing oxygen to human beings on the planet. The Van Mahotsav week is a reminder that we must protect forests and stop deforestation and practice the <u>*3R rule- Reduce, Reuse*</u> <u>*and Recycle.*</u>

Classes: Pre -Nursery – Grade 2

Activity: Plantation Drive

Day & Date: Wednesday, 5th July, 2023

Materials Required: (Seeds)

Description: Facilitator will discuss the importance of trees and forest in our life followed by seed sowing activity in the school ground.

3. Show and Tell:

Colors are connected to different moods and impressions. Every color represents something. Children are more drawn towards bright colors like red, yellow, green, blue, and

pink. Through this activity children will explore why do they like a particular colour and will also understand the importance of other colours.

Classes: Pre- Nursery – Grade 2

Activity: My Favourite Colour

Day & Date: Monday, 10th July, 2023

Description: Children will prepare two-three lines about their favourite colour. They will carry a prop related to their favourite colour.

4 Mango Day

National Mango day is celebrated to felicitate the National Fruit of India. India is largest producer and exporter of mangoes. Mango day is celebrated every year on June 22nd dedicated to the delicious fruit that people love to eat. **Day & Date:** Friday, 21st July, 2023

a).Classes: Pre Nursery and Nursery
Activity: Colour your Mango
Description: Facilitator will discuss about Mango day followed by colouring activity on the cutout of Mango.
Material required: Poster colour and paint brush

b). Classes: KG, Grade 1 and 2

Activity: Mango Race

Description: activity: Facilitator will discuss about different varieties of mangoes followed by the mango race. Children will be divided into groups and will wear props of different varieties of Mangoes. Winners will be awarded with small badges of mangoes.

5. Tiger's Day

International Tiger Day is a global event that is celebrated every year for Tiger conservation. The day aims to build a worldwide system that will be dedicated to protecting tigers and their natural habitats.

Day & Date: Friday, 28st July, 2023

- a). Classes: Pre- Nursery and Nursery

b). Classes: KG and 1

Activity: Headgear Making

Description: activity: Facilitator will discuss about Tiger Day followed by dabbing activity on the cutout of tiger.

c).Classes: Grade 2 Activity: Poster making Theme: Tiger's Day Materials Required & Rules:

- One coloured A4 size pastel sheets.
- Poster colours, Crayons, Pencil colours, paint brushes.
- Poster should be based on the theme with slogan.
