Greetings from The Millennium School, Greater Noida (W)!

At TMS Greater Noida (W), we believe that Parents are our partners in education. Assessment is an important tool for teachers, students, parents that helps raise the standards of learning across the school community. New Education Policy 2020 emphasizes on transforming assessments to be formative, regular and skill based. We follow a very progressive E-DAC™ Assessment system that focusses on students' learning of skills rather than content.

A pre-requisite for authentic assessment is a positive environment based on trust and confidence. Therefore, we ensure that our parents are apprised of all our academic as well as extra-curricular policies and programs.

ASSESSMENT VISION

1. Ongoing – The E-DAC™ Assessment system is a comprehensive and continuous assessment system that is embedded in the daily teaching-learning process. It does not rely on periodic pen paper tests heavily, rather the ongoing assessments ensure that the weightage is distributed throughout the academic session evenly.
2. Authentic – Since assessments are embedded in the everyday teaching learning, they provide teachers with a true authentic data on child's learning so that they can create a suitable Performance Enhancement Plan and remediate in a timely manner.
3. Manageable and Stress free – Formative assessments are of smaller duration and assess a small part of syllabus, thereby reducing stress on children and parents.
4. Experiential Projects – Our students engage in solving real world problems through experiential project based learning. These projects also form the integral component of the assessments.
5. Socio-emotional and mental health – Academic learning and achievement have to be accompanied by holistic and mental well-being of our students. Students' soft skills are also assessed frequently by means of AOAD (Assessment of Affective Domain).

STRUCTURE

1. Assessment in these grades is continuous and ongoing.
2. All assessments will be Learning outcome based as per NEP standards and consists of-

- **Learning Outcomes-**

- Learning Outcomes as per NEP for each subjects are listed grade wise.
- Pedagogical process and assessment items for each learning outcome is designed keeping age-level and individual learning styles of learners.

- **Assessment-**

- It will be conducted on day to day basis within the classroom.
- Assessment items may include- FAs as per EDAC, pen-paper tests and worksheets, Oral test, Speaking and listening, recitation, collaborative activities, projects etc.
- Students will be graded on the basis of predefined rubrics.

3. Grading System-

3. Do not over emphasize on the assessment performance, this leads to unnecessary stress.
4. Let students work and study independently but ensure that support is provided whenever needed.
5. Encourage children to seek help from teachers.
