SEE Learning

Objective: To introduce the concepts of sharing and caring to Foundational wing learners and foster empathy and cooperation skills.

Classes: Pre-Nursery - UKG

- ➤ Week 1 Activity: Teacher will talk about importance of sharing & caring, followed by a story narration. Students will have a special activity where each of them will get a chance to share something with a friend.
- ➤ Week 2 Activity: Children will be engaged in role-play where one acts upset or in need. Others offer comfort or help, demonstrating caring. Reflect on actions' impact and feelings.
- ➤ Week 3 Activity: Teacher will give each child chart paper and markers to draw themselves sharing or caring for others. Volunteers share their artwork, describing their drawings. Emphasize positive feelings from sharing and caring.

Classes I -II

- ➤ Week 1 Activity: Teacher will Initiate discussion on sharing and caring, noting students' responses. Children will be given scenarios for role-play to explore sharing emotions.
- ➤ Week 2 Activity: Teacher will narrate a story on sharing is caring. Engage students with questions about characters' actions and feelings. Students will be encouraged to recognize and discuss examples of sharing and caring, emphasizing their importance.
- ➤ Week 3 Activity: Students will collaborate on an art project, using materials provided to create posters illustrating sharing and caring. Groups present their work, explaining their choices, fostering creativity and discussion.
