Given below are the activities for the January 2022:

Classes: I – VIII

1. Life Skills Activity

Topic: Personal Hygiene

Day & Date: Every Monday 1st Period

Skill Assessed: Self-awareness and General awareness.

Assessment: There is a proverb that says: “Cleanliness is half your health”, and this is one of the reasons why children should learn about personal hygiene and good, healthy habits from a young age. Personal hygiene comprises various day-to-day activities such as bathing, brushing teeth, and washing hands.

Whether they go to the school, a park, or any other place, children come into contact with dirt and dust that carry infection-causing microorganisms. In fact, there are germs everywhere in the environment. We can prevent this by teaching personal hygiene habits.

Activity 1: Facilitator will show videos on Personal hygiene and do classroom discussion.

Activity 2: Go on a Germ Hunt

Germs are microscopic, meaning you can't see them with naked eyes. To help children understand that even their clean hands have germs on them.

Step 1: Ask your children to look at their hands and tell you if they are clean. Most children will say 'Yes'. Now, invite them to touch various surfaces around the class, like cupboard, shelves, lockers, soft board etc.

Step 2: Ask your children again, if they think their hands are clean. Reinforce the concept that germs are microscopic organisms that cannot be seen by naked eye

and ask them the same question again. Most children will agree that their hands still look clean.

Step3: Now, take a baby wipe and gently wipe their hands. You will notice the wipe will turn brown. Show this to your children and tell them that those are the germs that were sticking to their hands.

Activity 3: Students will create “Self-care cards with hygiene tips”

Learning Outcome: Students will become aware of the importance of personal hygiene.
