Given below are the activities for the October 2022:

Classes: I - VIII

1. Life Skills Activity

Topic: Anti Bullying – Be a buddy not a bully.

Day & Date: Every Monday 1st Period

Description: Bullying occurs when someone uses words or actions to intimidate someone into doing what they want. The person being bullied often feels powerless over what is happening, and the situation typically happens over and over again.

We often think of bullying as being a physical act in which someone pushes, shoves, and hurts someone else deliberately, but bullying can also be emotional. Calling someone names, spreading lies and rumours about them, making verbal threats, and sending mean comments to someone via social media are all examples of emotional bullying. This kind of intimidation often goes unnoticed as it's easier to hide from others, but the damage can be just as bad, if not worse than traditional forms of physical bullying.

Skill Assessed: Decision Making, Critical Thinking & Awareness

Activity 1: Wrinkled Wanda

- Students will trace an outline of a full body person.
- Students will write unkind, rude, and disrespectful statements all over the outline.
- After Wanda is completely filled with a variety of negative comments, the students crumple the drawing, and then un-crumple it.
- Teacher will explain to the class that these drawings are examples of what negative comments can do to a person who is bullied.

Activity 2: The Toothpaste Activity

- One student will come to the front of the room.
- Masking tape to be put on the length of the table.
- The student will run a bead of toothpaste on the length of the masking tape.
- Ask the students to put the toothpaste back in the tube.
- Obviously, it can't be done. This is an example of how hurtful words once spoken cannot be taken back.

Activity 3: Counselling session by counsellor.

Learning outcome: Students will learn how to:

- · Raise and maintain awareness of bullying;
- Increase pupils' interest and motivation towards activities with a preventive character;
- Encourage pupils to face problems;
- Develop pupils' team spirit;
- To get the parents involved in its prevention;
- Reduce the frequency and extent of aggression;
- Encourage students to take a stand against bullying;
- Behave properly in school, online and in bus.
